Terrain:	Relatively flat/level landscape - always a paved pathway and ground floor entrance to resort amenities, to all accommodation buildings and to appropriately noted/accessible ground floor rooms.
Communal areas:	The Reception and Boathouse buildings are both wheelchair accessible from the outside, with ramps to all buildings including the pool decks.
Parking:	One designated Handicapped parking space for every building located directly in front or closest/most accessible to the building (6 spaces in total)
Accessible/Adapted Accommodation:	Accessible friendly one and two bedrooms are located on the ground floor with ramp access. Bathrooms have space under the sinks for a wheelchair.
Other Accommodation:	There is an elevator in the Lodge building on demand. Wheelchair and service access only.

Accessible Outings & Excursions:	Numerous level and graded pathways and scenic walking trails nearby. The Village at Blue Mountain Events Plaza is fully accessible (outdoor, festival-style access to music and activities – no admission cost and regularly scheduled throughout the year). There is a local Movie Cinema which is fully accessible. Georgian Bay Boat Cruise operator that is fully accessible (Midland Boat Cruises).
Proximity/Accessibility to local supermarkets/shops, etc.	7 minute drive to full service grocery that is accessible. 1 minute drive (or 5 minute walk/stroll along level road side and some sidewalks) to smaller grocery store and /dining/shopping – all of which are accessible (no stairs - located on ground floor)
Public Transport:	Limited but available – just a few times daily service between the nearby Collingwood and Blue Mountain Resort - does have accessibility enabled vehicles. A local taxi service can provide accessible taxi service to any nearby destination.
Haemodialysis clinics close to resort:	Collingwood Marine & General Hospital – mainfloor dialysis clinic (12 minute drive from resort). The G&M's Dialysis Unit has six stations operating six days per week. Three shifts of patients are dialysed daily. The unit's maximum capacity is thirty-two patients. From time to time there is space available to accommodate transient patients.
