

Tips for your Belize Holiday

Thank you for your interest in booking your vacation with us at Royal Caribbean Resort Belize. We look forward to welcoming you to our tropical paradise.

Here are a few tips to help ensure that you have a wonderful time on Ambergris Caye, San Pedro, Belize:

1. Transportation from the International Airport to the island of Ambergris Caye

By Flight – Royal Caribbean Resort is a Tropic Air Agent. So our front desk personnel can easily book your **15-20min local flights** to Ambergris Caye from International Belize Airport for additional fee. The flight's cost is about **\$160US round trip per person.** Pre-payment or payment upon arrival at the international airport are both accepted. To book, please provide flight arrival and departure times, all passengers' full names as stated as on passport to our front desk personnel.

By Boat – A taxi costing roughly **\$30US** will take you from the international airport to the water taxi terminal in Belize City. You will then need to take the water taxi/ferry to Ambergris Caye. One-way tickets are **\$35US** per person. The boat ride is approximately 1hr and 45 minutes.

There are two water taxi companies travelling to San Pedro daily, <u>San Pedro Belize Express</u> Website: http://www.belizewatertaxi.com/ and Ocean Ferry Belize Website: http://www.oceanferrybelize.com/

San Pedro Taxi – From the San Pedro Airport or Water Taxi dock, to Royal Caribbean Resort, 1 Seagrape Drive, San Pedro, the local taxi will cost no more than 10\$ US and take 10-15min and take you to the resort.

2. Arrival Times

Early Arrival - If you arrive at the resort prior to check in time, 14:00 PM, you may leave your luggage with the front desk and enjoy the cool refreshing pool, catch a bite at the restaurant on site or play a quick game of bowling (ask the guys at the restaurant about it) until your room is ready for you.

Late Arrival - If you arrive after the Office is closed, a note will be left for you on the office door. It will ask you to knock on the door of our staff member, Kimberly, in room 43# (right across from the office) and she will show you to your room.

Island Transportation - people mainly get around by bike or by Golf Cart. *Bicycling* is a great way to travel around the island or explore the town of San Pedro without worrying about finding a parking space. Bikes make it easy to visit nearby bars and restaurants. The North-South Road



offers easy cycling but beware of the golf carts and occasional trucks and cars – there is no bike path. Biking the beach is slower but a lovely way to see the coastline. Sometimes the soft sand means pushing the bike. When making the bridge crossing at the North end of San Pedro town, there is no fee for bicycles (US\$2.50 is charged to golf carts). The resort provides bikes for rent, the daily rate is 9\$US

Golf Carts are ideal for exploring the 25 miles (40 kilometers) long island. Whether venturing to the southern tip or the far northern end of Ambergris Caye, golf carts make the trip fun and easy. The golf carts can be driven beyond the paved roads to the hard-packed dirt and sand roads. They make shopping easy and are convenient when stepping out for an evening of dinner and dancing where each restaurant and bar across the island has a different ambiance and cuisine. The resort provides gold carts for rent as well.

3. On-Site Bar-Restaurants;

Toast Restaurant & Bar is our beachfront, onsite restaurant and bar situated opposite the resort's luxurious pool. Open daily, you can enjoy breakfast, lunch, and dinner with a spectacular ocean view. Please inquire with the front desk regarding the hours.

Our virgin beach is a two-minute walk south of Royal Caribbean Resort. The beach includes a volleyball beach court, beach games, a bonfire pit, comfortable lounging, and hammocks. The Cafe & Pub serves a wide variety of cocktails, beer and coffee in addition to a menu of local cuisine.

- 4. **On-site Massage** Quiet and relaxation are vital for the perfect Caribbean vacation. A private masseuse is available for both spa and in-room massages upon request.
- 5. **Water and Jungle Tours** Belizean jungle tours such as cave tubing and ziplining, scuba diving and snorkelling around the 2nd largest reef in the world and many other excursions, can be booked with the on-site tour company.
- 6. **Safety** is paramount. Security men in the area is identified by PATROL written on their uniforms. They are part of the 'Neighbourhood watch' and are here to make sure everything is in order. Kindly note that the office has a small safe for valuables where requested.
- 7. **Currency Exchange:** \$1US = \$2BZE (USD is accepted anywhere in Belize)
