Terrain:	The terrain surrounding the club is very flat at the front of the property, but there is a gradual hill on Blackcomb Way. The access down to the center of the courtyard is by steps only, however if you follow Blackcomb way down to the 4 way stop and turn right after P2 you can access the courtyard through the totem poles. One thing to note, when you are taking this route to the court yard there is one curb up and one curb down. Last the check-in Bay does have a wheelchair accessible ramp; this allows you direct access into the club lobby.
Communal areas:	The building is wheelchair accessible. There are elevators to all levels. There is also direct access from street level to the main entry door by a ramp. Braille and accessibility signage has been added on property. Door closers (max of 5lbs push) installed in all public washrooms and sales entrance door.
Parking:	5 accessible parking spaces in the garage.
Accessible/Adapted	One bedroom accessible units are available.
Accommodation:	 Handrails by the tub, toilet and shower stall. A 2" high lip into the shower stall but has been designed for a wheelchair to be rolled in. There are no cabinets below the sink, so a wheelchair can roll right up. Shower has a removable shower head. There is a soaker tub.
Other Accommodation:	Doors are wide enough for wheelchair access. Light switches are lower on the walls. Visual fire alarms. Lowered thermostats. Lowered one section of the kitchen counter New stove is lowered with control mounted right at the front

Equipment Measurements:	The Shower Seat H 16" X W 16" The shower bench located inside shower H 18 ½" X W 19" The bed height H 28" The wheel chair H of seat 19" W of seat 17 1/2 "D of seat 17". We do not have a raised toilet seat, but here are the measurements W14" X 18" L

Proximity/Accessibility to local supermarkets/shops, etc.	Just a 2 min walk across the street you have access to some retail shops and restaurants, this is in the Upper Village. Inside the club we have the Upper Village Market that sells your basic groceries. The largest grocery store is called the IGA it's just a 5 min drive or a 15 min walk. At the Market Place there is 2 hour complimentary parking with some allocated spots for someone with a disability. The lower village is a less than 5 min drive from the club or a 10-15 min walk, here you can shop for souvenirs, clothing or eat out at one of Whistler restaurants.
Public Transport:	Whistler Transit -there is bus stop located across the street, here you can catch the number 5 which takes you to the lower village. The bus drops you off at the Village Gondola Transit Exchange where you can make other bus connections if you wish. One thing to note the number 5 bus is a complimentary shuttle service.
