

This notification is to you to inform you of an update issued by the Canarian Government on the 05<sup>th</sup> of December 2020, with regards to amendments to the current legislation. We are communicating this to you because these changes are effective immediately and therefore it is important that everyone complies.

In the Pool Bar, table sizes are restricted to a maximum of 4 people. This is also applicable to groups gathering in the communal areas such as at the pool tables etc., where the maximum number is also restricted to 4. Please do not queue at the bar.

In addition, the updated legislation stipulates curfew from 11pm to 6am. It is forbidden to go out on the street during this time.

We would also like to take this opportunity to reinforce that the current law in Spain, is that face masks must be worn in all public areas within the Resort. This includes, but is not limited to: Reception, communal areas including the corridors and passageways around the resort, the garage area, pool bar and restaurant (except when consuming food or drinks). The law also states that masks must also be worn in the street and in both open air and enclosed spaces. The use of a mask is mandatory for anyone above the age of 6 years old. The Government has reiterated the importance of wearing the mask correctly, ensuring it is covering both the mouth and nose.
