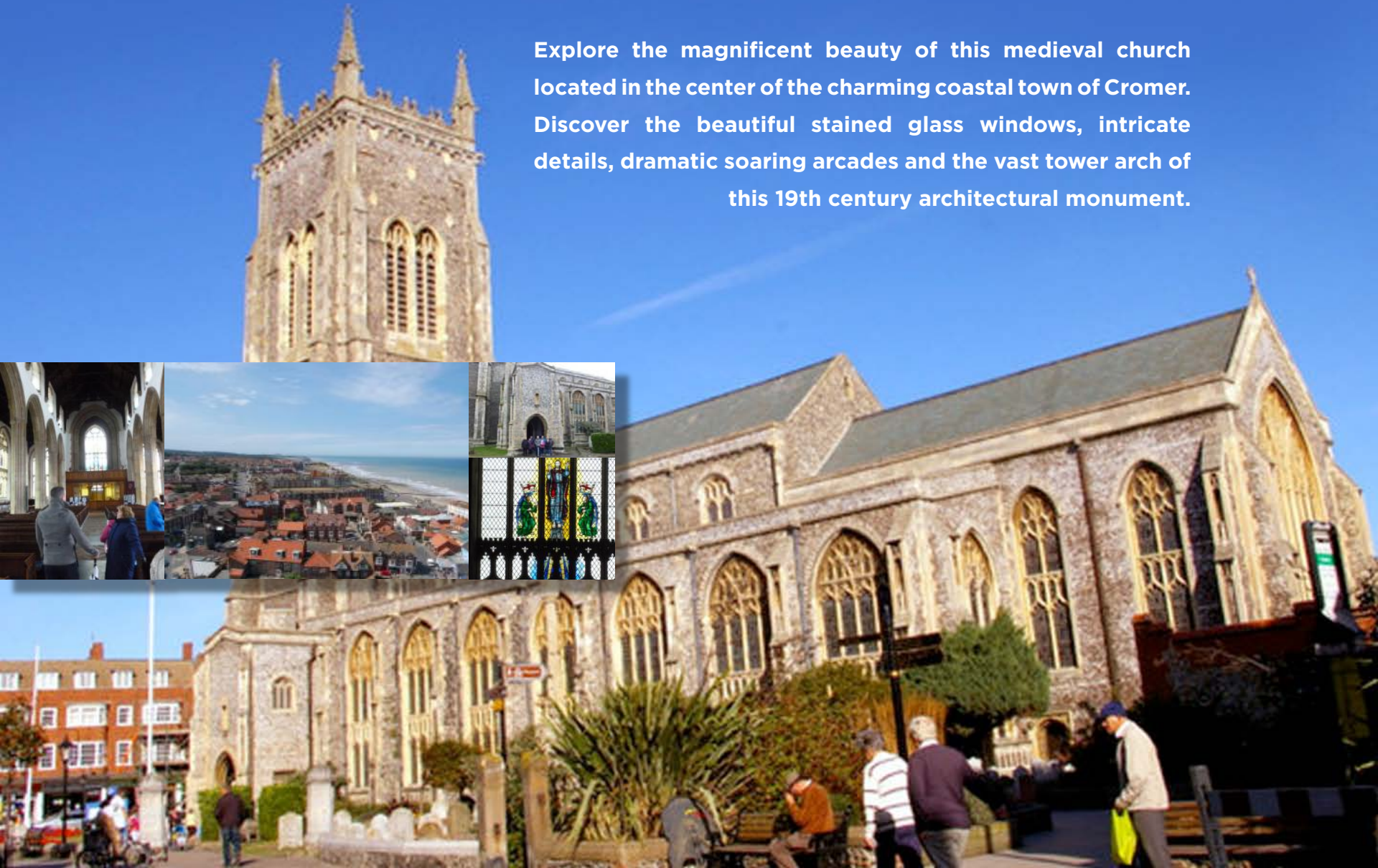
CROMER LIGHTHOUSE

RNLI HENRY BLOGG MUSEUM

Erected in honor of the RNLI's most decorated lifeboat man, this historic museum tells the story of Henry Blogg and some of his most extraordinary rescues as he helped save 873 lives along the coast of Cromer.
