

### **Desert Willow Golf Resort (100 ft)**

Desert Willow Golf Resort is arguably one of the finest public access courses in the country today. Recognized for its environmentally sound design and construction by both the Smithsonian Institute magazine and National Geographic Traveler magazine, Desert Willow has garnered a great deal of attention. The Firecliff Course is a championship tournament course offering over 180 sand features, narrow fairways, dry-river beds, bubbling brooks and beautiful desert vegetation. It has hosted the Frank Sinatra Celebrity Tournament, the Subaru Southern California Team Championship, and the Prestige at Palm Desert, a NCAA tournament. The Mountain View Course is also a championship resort course offering undulating fairways, dramatic visuals of the local mountains, tranquil lakes and trickling streams. Both courses offer a choice of five sets of tees making play enjoyable for all levels.

### **Joshua Tree National Park (37.5 mi)**

The meeting point of the Colorado and Mojave Deserts provides opportunities to explore one of the most famous National Parks in America.

### **El Paseo Drive (4.8 mi)**

Palm Desert is a world-class shopping venue famous for its "mini Rodeo Drive" called El Paseo Drive. Palm Trees lining El Paseo sparkle year round with Christmas lights, and an impressive collection of sculptures and art forms decorate a two-mile stretch in the middle of the promenade. While strolling this popular area be sure to stop in at the Gardens Shopping Center for a peek at its manicured desert gardens, prestigious boutiques and great restaurants. Also a highlight in the Palm Desert area is the Westfield Shopping Center. This massive indoor shopping center features its own movie theater and a selection of specialty shops and department stores.

### **Palm Springs Aerial Tram (20.4 mi)**

Palm Springs Aerial Tram boasts the world's largest rotating tramcars. The 2.5 mile ascent takes you up the Mount San Jacinto Mountains, with panoramic views as the floor of the tram rotates 360 degrees. At the top there are 54 miles of hiking trails, from nature walks to awe-inspiring ascents for the most avid outdoor enthusiast.
